The actions of the Rapid Express Team on January 20, 2011 lead to the uncovering of a potential security vulnerability and helped the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) in Connecticut reduce risk to passenger aviation at Bradley International Airport.

Your staff recognized the actions of an unqualified individual as a potential threat to civil aviation, and reported the incident to TSA. As a result of your staff reporting this incident, an investigation into the circumstances provided TSA with the opportunity to review the incident and take the appropriate corrective action.

Partnerships between TSA and the Private sector will continue to go a long way in helping TSA reduce vulnerabilities throughout the industry and making aviation more secure.
